

CONDITIONS FOR ADVANCEMENT TO THE NEXT GRADE

Students are advanced to the next grade automatically.

Based on the internal agreements, a student is believed to be underachieving, and thus prone to having major difficulties in the next grade, if he/she has achieved a final grade of **3, 2 or 1 in more than two subjects in MYP1-3** and a final grade **3, 2 or 1 in more than one subject in MYP4-5 at the end of the second term**. If such a case occurs, the student **will have to retake** the summative assessment from the subject(s). The retake exams are usually held the last week of August.

If the student fails to meet the required standards, the student and their parents are invited to a conference with the teachers and the headmistress to discuss the situation and agree on further steps.
